Our Program

Our T-Th (2 days a week) program is designed for the 3 year old child. Developmentally appropriate activities will be specifically planned for those two days. Introduction to letters and numbers are part of the curriculum. Activities and projects often extend over the two day period. If your child is 3 years old by September 1st by the enrolling year, he/she is eligible for this program.

Our MWF (3 days a week) program is specifically planned for the 4-5 year old.

The day includes pre-K literacy curriculum, and a pre-K math program. Activities and projects often extend over the three days, with the final project completion on Friday. If your child is 4 years old by September 1st by the enrolling year, he/she is eligible for this program.

The 10 month Preschool program runs September through June.
